## Determine Ring Size With a Ring Size Chart

Use a ring that fits you to determine your ring size. Place your ring over the nearest size circle. The inner edge of the ring should align with the outer edge of the circle. If your ring appears to fit between two sizes, buy the larger size.


## Another Way to Determine Your Ring Size:

If you don't know your ring size, simply follow these instructions and you will be able to determine it.

1. Cut a strip of paper no wider than $1 / 4$ "
2. Wrap the paper snugly around your finger and mark the paper where it meets.
3. Measure the marked length of paper and compare it to the chart below.

Note: If your knuckle is significantly larger than the base of your finger, you should measure the knuckle as described above and pick a size somewhere in between the two.
